Field Set for Curling Junior Nationals at Detroit Curling Club – FERNDALE, Jan. 19 -- The field is complete for the curling Junior Nationals at Detroit Curling Club Jan 27-Feb 3. Ten men's and ten women's teams will compete for championships and the right to represent the United States at Worlds. The field features 2017 junior champions and world silver medalists Team Stopera, who will test their mettle as they aspire for 2022 Olympics. On the women's side, 2017 champion skip Annemarie Dubberstein returns with two of last year's rink-mates and a new skip.

Opening Ceremonies are at 1:00 pm Saturday (Jan 27) and the competition begins at 4:00 pm. It continues until Saturday, Feb 3, with the finals at 1:30 pm. From Sunday through Thursday, curling action begins at 8:00 am and continues with draws at noon, 4:00 pm and 8:00 pm. The round robin winds up Friday morning and the top four teams advance to a Page playoff. The winners will represent the United States at Junior World Championships in Aberdeen, Scotland, Mar. 3-11.

Tickets are \$10 for the day and \$50 for the entire week.

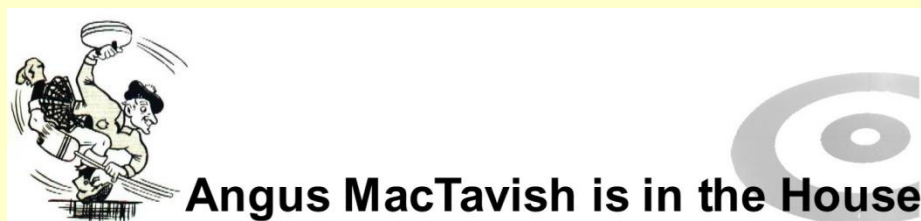

The Detroit Curling Club was once an Auto Plant – May 15, 1913. Studebaker designates The Club as Plant #14. The Studebaker Corporation has leased the Detroit Curling Club building on Forest Avenue as a storage warehouse for radiators, coils, springs and other supplies. This is the fourteenth building that the Studebaker Corporation has acquired in the capital of automobiledom.

This arrangement was only for the non-curling months, since we know there was curling in the building in the winter of 1913-14.

Communication and Website News

DCC Website Instructions for Signing In – Every member should be aware of the procedures to set up your accessibility to all the great web site features. If you have not signed in yet, follow these instructions and save your user name and password to stay informed. Keep these instructions handy in case you forget your sign in information.

Retrieving Your Username & Password

You will only be able to complete these steps once you are seeing the new website when you go to www.detroitcurlingclub.com. If you do not see, "Forgot Login," as mentioned below you will need to wait a while and try loading the site again.

1. On the right side, under the Member Login section, click on the words Forgot Login.
2. Click to check the box for Lost Username and a space to enter your email address will appear.
3. Enter you email address and click the Send Username button. If you see a message that your email address does not exist on the site, please email membership@detroitcurlingclub.com so we can update your email address.
4. Check your email and you should receive a message with your username.
5. Return to the DCC website and again click on the words Forgot Login under the Member Login section.
6. Click to check the box for Lost Password and spaces for entering both your username and email address will appear.
7. Enter both your username and password and click the Send Password button.
8. Check your email and you should receive a message with a new password.

9. Return to the DCC website and use your username and new password to log in.

Changing Your Password

1. After you have logged in, click on My Information under the Member Menu on the right side.
2. Near the top left of your profile click on Edit and then choose Update Your Profile.
3. Click on User Info to switch to the username and password settings.
4. Enter your desired password in the space provided, and enter it again in the Verify Password field.
5. Click the Update button to save your changes.
