DCC Received Past President's Pins -

Peggy Woodhouse donated her father's (Paul L. Moreland) curling pin collection to the club last year. Paul was president of DCC for the 1955-56 season. He competed in three U.S. men's nationals and was a member of the 1952 Scots Tour. In addition to being a skilled and devoted curler, Paul was an avid sailor and member of the Grosse Pointe Yacht Club. Born in Iowa, he began his professional career as a teacher at old Eastern High School in Detroit, before becoming a successful stock broker. He died in 1992 at age 87.



Peggy told stories of ice skating in the 1940s at the Forest Avenue club on Sundays after Sinners Bonspiel. Sadly, Peggy died in February, 2018 (age 83), before she could see her father's pins on display at the club.

DCC Member Wins Bronze at Senior
Men's Worlds – Sean Silver, who plays in
the Tuesday Men's and Thursday Open
leagues, played second for Team Jeff Wright
that earned a bronze medal at this year's
Championship in Oestersund, Sweden last
month. Sean rejoined teammates Wright,
Russ Armstrong, Steve Waters and Russ
Brown from his time in Chicago, before he
and wife Annie Swisshelm relocated to
Grosse Pointe recently. Sean and Annie
have been DCC members since 2016-17
season.

Sean's is the first world medal for a DCC member since 1963 when Mike Slyziuk, Nelson Brown, Ernie Slyziuk and Walter Hubchick won the U.S. title and bronze at the World Championship.



Team Wright complied a 6-4 record in pool play and qualified for playoffs. They beat Finland and undefeated Switzerland in the first two playoff games before falling to Sweden in the semi-finals. That set up the bronze medal match with Scotland, whom Team Wright overcame handily for the win. Sean summed up his team's strong performance by saying, "It was just a great experience!"
