**Membership Renewal and League Registration Now Open –** Online league registration and membership renewal is now available on the new Detroit Curling Club website. Use your website username and password to login.

Do NOT use the Sign Up link below the login section. If you do not remember your username or password follow the steps included in the DCC registration email to retrieve them.

Changes for 2018-2019 – The Class C Limited Curling membership now only allows for curling in the Tuesday Morning R.O.C.s league. Members who have never held a Class A membership and were C Limited Curling members last season will be allowed to sign up as Class B Intro members for this season only. Note: the signup form may incorrectly allow CLC members to select the Sunday league - we are working to fix this error.

A new, experimental, open league has been added late Friday nights at 10:15 PM. Eric Kortebein is the drawmaster and a description from him has been added to the league list on our website.

**League Registration Steps –** Once you have logged in, you will now see an option for Member Registration listed under League Information on the right side of the page. Priority registration for returning league members will be through the end of the day on Saturday, October 13th.

The steps for registering are described in the DCC registration email. At the very end of the process, after reconfirming all of your choices, you will see the payment options. You may still pay by check, if you would like, and the club mailing address is listed. If you choose to pay by credit card click the PayPal button and you will be taken to the PayPal website to complete your payment.
